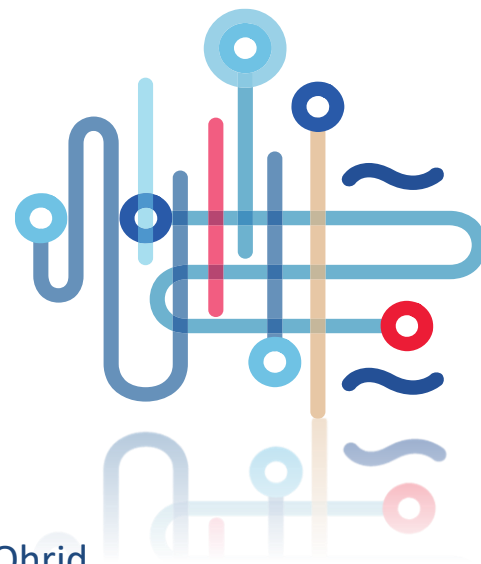

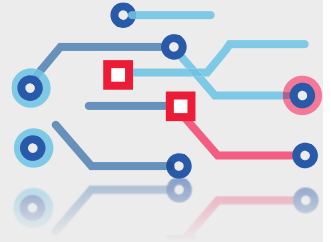

- National CERT's host: Regulatory Agency for Electronic Communications and Postal Services - RATEL

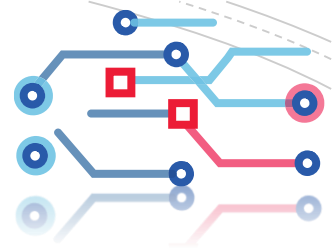


Other Bodies in Cyber Security

Provision of early warnings, alarms and announcements

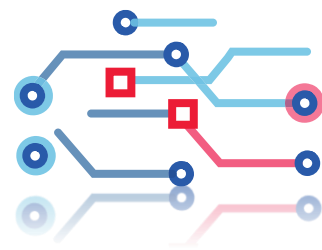
Provision of advice related to notified incidents

Raising awareness of public and legal entities

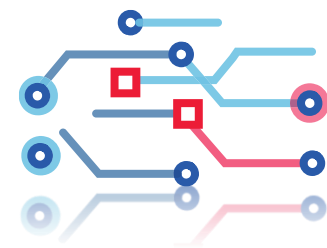

National CERT - National Level Coordination of Risk Prevention Activities



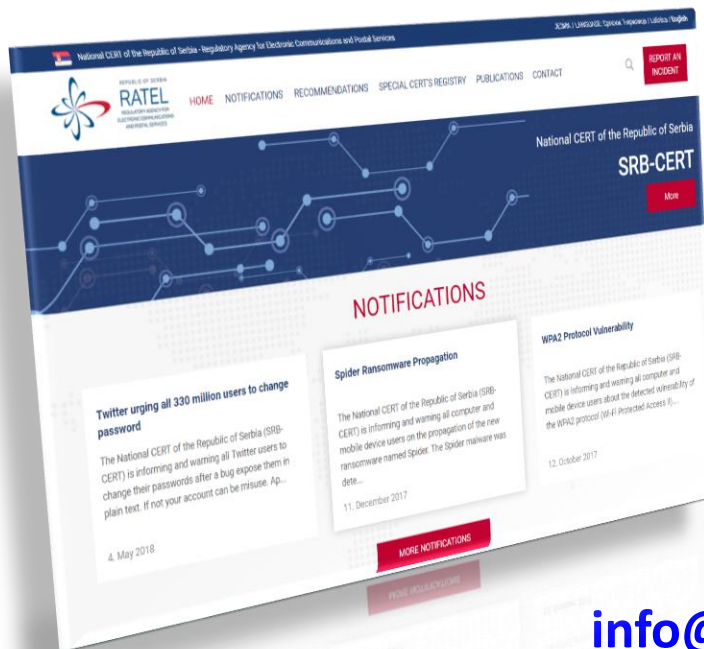
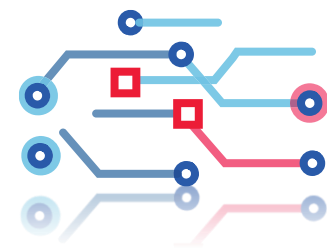
- Gathering and exchange of information related to information security risks
- Notification of responsible parties and the general public
- Direct cooperation with the Competent Authority, Special CERTs, private and public entities, CERTs of Independent Operators and Government CERT
- Promotion of the adoption and implementation of prescribed and standardized measures concerning risk management and mitigation as well as classification of data and incidents.

National Incident Reporting Scheme



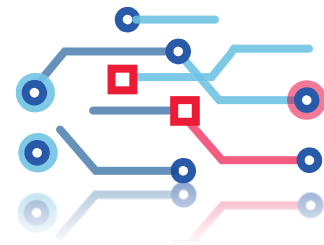

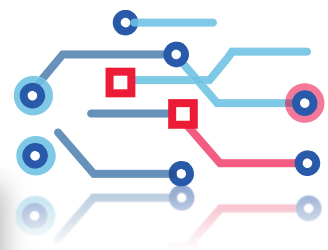


International Incident Information Sharing
